
# ITE Monitoring, Review, and Moderation for Māori Medium

#### Kaupapa

 We are at the stage where we need to begin developing a new process for monitoring, review, and moderation of Kaupapa Māori/Māori Medium ITE programmes.

 Before we get this work underway, we'd like to hear from you about what you need from a new process.

• We expect this work will take at least 12 months to complete (based on the timeframe for this work with English Medium ITE programmes).

# What is monitoring, review, and moderation?

 Processes that help us (Teaching Council) understand whether individual ITE programmes are operating as approved.

An opportunity to provide additional support if needed.

• These processes can also give us insights into any themes or trends that might be emerging across the sector.

#### What is MRM cont...?

 Monitoring – a continuous or periodic process that allows for regular collection of information

Review – quality assurance at one point in time

 Moderation – an opportunity to collectively discuss and consider national consistency of assessment (could also include a focus on different themes).
